Pray 'The Lord's Prayer' in Matthew 6:13:

And lead us not into temptation,

but deliver us from evil . . .

Step #4

Pray that the Holy Spirit will fill you with the mind of Christ. Philippians 2:5

Let this mind be in you,

which was also in Christ Jesus:

Step #5

Remind yourself of your decision in Step #1. "By God's promise I have accepted a clean heart and a right spirit. I will use the Potent Power of God's Words to Subdue Satan." Psalm 51:12

Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.

Step #6

Do not allow Satan to distract or 'fog' your brain, so that you become lured, **bewitched**, **captivated**, **captured**, **charmed**, **enchanted**, **ensnared**, **hooked**, **seduced**, **or trapped**. (Snapped!))

Step #7

Use any or all of God's Potent Power that follows, and you will be able to subdue subtle Satan.
